FROM OUR DISTRICT REGARDING VACCINE CLINICS

A series of four, free, walkup COVID-19 vaccine clinics for ages 5 and older will be held over the next four weekends at the Sonoma County Fairgrounds. The clinics will take place from 9:00am - 4:00pm, Saturdays and Sundays, for four weekends beginning Saturday, January 29th and ending Sunday, February 20th at the Garrett Building - 1350 Bennett Valley Road. No appointments are necessary or accepted. First, second and booster doses are available which provide the opportunity for school staff and volunteers to receive their booster ahead of the upcoming February 1, 2022 deadline which requires educational workers to receive their booster or participate in required testing, twice a week.
