What To Do if You See One:

Don't Open It! If you already opened it, just don't click anything.

Report It! Tell your email it's a bad email by using the "Report Phishing" button.

Delete It! Once it's reported, toss it in the trash! How to Spot a Fake Email:

Does the sender's email look weird? That's a clue it's fake.

Is there a link or attachment you didn't expect?
 Be careful!

 Does it ask for passwords, money, or other personal info? No way!

If you ever feel unsure, ask for help. We're here to make sure you stay safe and awesome online. Thanks for being email detectives! Let's keep our inboxes safe and have an amazing year ahead.
