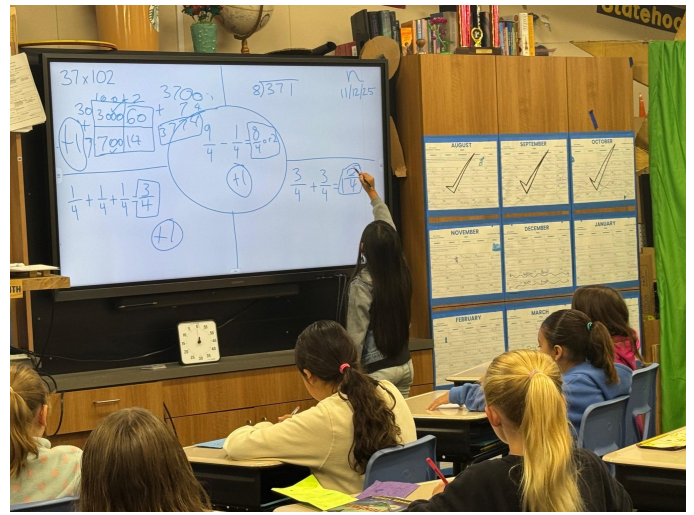
Thank you for everything you do to support our students and our school community.
